ACTIVITIES WEEK – Monday 8th – Friday 12th July 2024

Activities Week offers your child an opportunity to become involved in a wide range of activities. The activities on offer are educational and enjoyable and can provide new challenges and opportunities for your child to develop the skills gained during their time at Churchill Academy & Sixth Form. We encourage students to try something new for the first time and hope they will discover an interest that they will want to continue in their own time.

During Activities Week, students should be logging on to their Unifrog account to record the activities they have done and the skills that they have developed.

The aim of this booklet is to give you information about the activities offered so that you can talk over the choices with your child. We have tried to ensure that everyone has access to a balanced range of activities throughout the week. Some activities have no cost but some involve expense, which has been kept as low as possible.

To make the allocation of activities as fair as possible, students will book themselves onto activities through Bromcom. If students have any concerns or problems during this process, they can speak with their tutor, Head of House, or with Mrs Woodley who is based in the main school office. It will be possible for students to book their activities on Bromcom either from home or at school. The bookings will commence on Monday 5th February 2024 and will close on Friday 16th February 2024.

It is also important to stress that once the activity schedule for students has been finalised, no changes will be possible, either before or during the week. Students are expected to attend school on every day of Activities Week, as during any other school week. If an activity is chargeable, the cost has been calculated based on all participants paying in full. Should a student be unable to attend a chargeable activity, a refund is not possible. We appreciate that this is a period of some financial hardship so may we draw your attention to the considerable number of activities at no or very low cost and we urge students to opt sensibly.

From the 1st March 2024, payment will be requested via ParentPay, with a deadline for payment of 3rd May 2024, if payment is not received by this date, your child will be removed from the activities that have not been paid for and placed on to free activities as available.

Students are expected to behave to a high standard during all activities, on or off site. Students reported for misbehaviour may be excluded from taking part in any off-site activities, and no refund will be available.

The timings of the school day for Activities Week follow the normal school timetable. However, please note that some activities have different timings, particularly some activities taking place off site and of course will be subject to traffic and travel conditions. Please ensure that you are able to get your child to and from school on the longer days when they are unable to use their usual school transport. Students are not expected to wear uniform during this week, Students should, however, wear appropriate clothes for the activities they are attending. We also expect our students to maintain their usual smart appearance.

No expensive personal items are to be taken on activities away from the Academy and normal Academy rules apply to activities taking place in the school. The Academy accepts no responsibility for personal items, which your child chooses to bring along during the week.

Staff commitment to this week is high and a great deal of preparation has gone into the provision of what we hope will be a very exciting and rewarding week.

Activities Week Booking System – Bromcom Student Portal:

- Only students will be able to book themselves onto activities through the Student Portal on Bromcom at home or in school, not parents.
- There is a button on the home page called Clubs.
- When you select an activity, a pop box will open asking you to enrol. When you have successfully joined, it will show in your club listings.
- If you change your mind during the booking period, you will need to see Mrs Woodley in the admin office.
- If an activity is full, you can ask to be added to the waiting list. Please ensure that you are booked onto an activity for this day; do not assume that you will get a space on the activity.
- Students will be able to book all their activities for the week, if they have chosen more than five activities these will be automatically deleted by the Academy admin team, so they need to think carefully before booking, as students will not be able to change any bookings.




