How to collect your Free School Meals (FSM)

If you have already been having food from the kitchens at Churchill then the process is the same.

The main difference is that you will have **£2.65** per day automatically added to your account at lunchtime each day.

Use your fingerprint or card to get your food at the till.



The money will not appear on the cash machines, the money will only appear to the kitchen staff on the till.

The FSM money cannot be saved up and it will disappear at the end of each day if you have not spent it.

You must use your FSM money to buy a substantial meal:

Students can choose from these items with their £2.65:

- Hot Meal from the menu , piece of fruit & traybake
- Sandwich, piece of fruit & traybake
- Pasta of the day (on days when available) piece of fruit & traybake
- Panini or Hot Deli Wrap on its own

Cartons of drink are chargeable but tap water is free of charge

REMEMBER- anything bought from the kitchens before school or at break time will be charged normally from your account.

You can still load money onto your account through ParentPay or by using the top-up machines located in the Hive and Windsor.



Any money you load yourself will remain on the card until you spend it.

You can collect your free school meal from any of the food areas.
