Headteacher's Reflection

After two years of pandemic disruption, formal public examinations returned in summer 2022 as we took further steps back towards the "new normal." But these were not quite examinations as normal: there were revisions to exams, advance notice of content that would be examined, and sheets of equations and key vocabulary were provided for certain subjects. For this reason – as well as the differential impact of the pandemic on different students up and down the country – these results are not comparable to those in previous years.

Despite all of that, the figures in the following pages represent individual triumphs and successes by individual young people in the wake of the most significant disruption to education in living memory. Their achievements are all the more remarkable, considering the circumstances in which they were made. We congratulate them all.
