ACTIVITIES WEEK – Monday 13th – Friday 17th July 2026

Activities Week is one of the cornerstones of our Personal Development Curriculum for students in Years 7, 8 & 9 and provides us with an opportunity to introduce the students to a wide range of extracurricular activities. Each year we look to provide a programme of opportunities that stretch and challenge our students, promote the development of individual and interpersonal skills, and help shape wider world attitudes and understanding.

We encourage students to try something new for the first time and hope they will discover an interest that they will want to continue in their own time.

During Activities Week, students should be logging on to their Unifrog account to record the activities they have done and the skills that they have developed.

The aim of this booklet is to give you information about the activities offered so that you can talk over the choices with your child. We have tried to ensure that everyone has access to a balanced range of activities throughout the week. Some activities have no cost, but some involve expense, which has been kept as low as possible.

To make the allocation of activities as fair as possible, students will book themselves onto activities through Bromcom. Please note that students are only allowed to book two activities in the first booking window. This first window will be open from Monday 2nd February at 19:00 and will close on Sunday 8th February at 19:00. The second window opens on Monday 9th February. The booking system will close Sunday 15th February 2026. (Please note, we have found that booking activities works better on the phone app).

Any student who books more than two activities in the first window will have all their activities removed in order to provide a full range of opportunities for the other students. If students have any concerns or problems during this process, they can speak with their tutor, Head of House, or with Mrs Woodley who is based in the main school office.

It is also important to stress that once the activity schedule for students has been finalised, no changes will be possible, either before or during the week. Students are expected to attend school every day during Activities Week, as per any other normal school week.

From Monday 2nd March 2026, payment will be requested via ParentPay, with a deadline for final payments on Friday 1st May 2026, if payment is not received by this date, your child will be removed from the activities that have not been paid for and placed onto free activities as available.

If an activity is chargeable, the cost has been calculated based on all participants paying in full. Should a student be unable to attend a chargeable activity, a refund is not possible. We appreciate that this is a period of some financial hardship so may we draw your attention to the considerable number of activities at no or very low cost, and we urge students to opt sensibly.

We work closely with the charity FEES Fund to help support families and students take part in extracurricular activities. The aim of FEES fund is to remove financial barriers, support skills development, build confidence, resilience and raise aspirations.

Students are expected to behave to a high standard during all activities, on or off site. Students reported for misbehaviour may be excluded from taking part in any off-site activities, and no refund will be available.

The timings of the school day for Activities Week follow the normal school timetable. However, please note that some activities have different timings, particularly activities taking place off site and may be subject to traffic and travel conditions. Please ensure that you can get your child to and from school on the longer days when they are unable to use their usual school transport. Students are not expected to wear uniform during this week, students should, however, wear appropriate clothes for the activities they are attending. We also expect our students to maintain their usual smart appearance.

No expensive personal items should be taken on activities away from the Academy and normal Academy rules apply to activities taking place in the school. The Academy accepts no responsibility for personal items, which your child chooses to bring along during the week.

Staff commitment to this week is high and a great deal of preparation has gone into the provision of what we hope will be a very exciting and rewarding week.

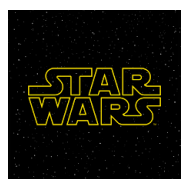
