Educational and Enrichment Voucher

We understand buying additional equipment and paying for activities can be expensive. Our students eligible for Pupil Premium will have access to the funding detailed below, for this academic year. It can't be rolled over to the following academic year.

£50 Educational Support:

This funding is designed to support your child academically. For example you may choose to use this to support:

- Additional materials for lessons such as having art/textiles equipment for your child.
- Additional textbooks or revision guides
- Educational trips

Year 10 Pupil Premium students will also receive a one-off additional £50 funding for revision guides. Information and letters will go out during the school year.

£50 Enrichment Support:

This funding is designed to support your child with enrichment activities. For example you may choose to use this to support:

- Activities week
- School trips
- Music Lessons
- Sports classes

Frequently asked questions

How do I use the funding?

My child has used all their Enrichment funding. Can we use the Educational funding for activities week?

No, the funding the Academy receives is to support your child academically. We understand it is important for students to take part in extra-curricular activities and have allocated funding towards this. Outside of the £50 enrichment funding the primary focus needs to be educational.

If the primary focus is educational can I use the Enrichment funding to support something educational?

Yes, you can choose to use the funding in this way.

My child has only recently become eligible for Pupil Premium, can they now access this funding?

Students are able to access Pupil Premium provision as soon as they receive confirmation that they meet the eligibility criteria for Pupil Premium.

Thank you but I don't feel like I need this funding –what will happen to this funding if it is not used?

The Academy aims to work together with families about how to use funding therefore we do not automatically fund activities as this is not always welcomed or needed. The unused funding will be put towards much needed provisions within Pupil Premium. The funding is ring fenced therefore the funding will always be used to support Pupil Premium services.
