Educational and Enrichment funding:

Each student has £100 funding available. £50 can be used towards educational resources (school trips, textbooks/ revision guides, materials for lessons) £50 can be used towards enrichment activities (Activities Week, school trips or after-school activity/sports/scouts).

Uniform Voucher:



You can get a £50 voucher or refund to help pay for new uniform. You can also have access to the free uniform store which provides good quality clean seconds.

Stationery Equipment:

All PP students can collect one stationery pack including a calculator, free of charge, from Reception.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium is funding from the government to help students reach their full potential at school. Here are some example reasons:

- A student could be on Free School Meals or have been in the past six years ,or
- A student who is currently being looked after by the local authority, or
- A student known to the Academy to have been adopted within the UK from Local Authority care, or
- A student who has a parent who is serving in the armed forces or have been in the past six years. These students are eligible for different funding -Service Pupil Premium

Will people know if I'm on Pupil Premium and why?

There are many reasons why students are Pupil Premium and this is private and personal to them. This means other students will not know the reason why someone is Pupil Premium.
