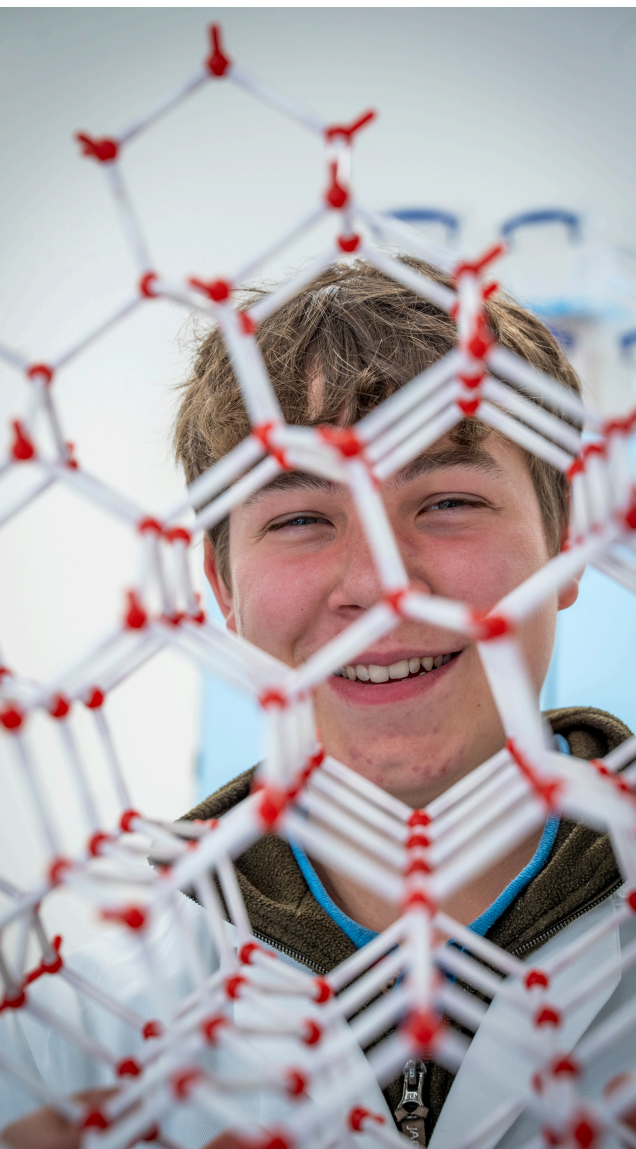

All of our Sixth Form courses are Level 3 qualifications, equivalent to A Levels. Most are A Levels, while some are vocational. Both A Levels and vocational qualifications, such as BTECs, hold equal value, although they differ in their learning styles and assessment methods. Students may apply for any combination of courses. Additionally, some subjects are available as AS qualifications, worth approximately half an A Level, and can be completed in Year 12.

As part of our Year 12 curriculum, students will have the opportunity to select an extension option in addition to their three main subjects. Students can choose from three options: the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), Core Maths or Study Skills.



The **Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)** is an AQA Level 3 course, equivalent to half an A Level. This involves completing a 5,000-word project on a topic of choice that lies outside of students' main subjects. Throughout the course, students will attend taught sessions and have regular one-on-one meetings with a supervisor to guide them through their research.

Core Maths is a Level 3 qualification designed to develop and apply practical mathematical skills in real-world contexts. Unlike traditional maths courses, Core Maths focuses on problem-solving techniques that students can use in everyday life, work or alongside other subjects.

Study Skills is an introductory programme aimed at easing the transition from GCSEs to A-Levels. It's often said that the jump between these two stages is significant. This course equips students with the tools and techniques to study more effectively at a higher level, giving students a better chance of achieving the grades they are aiming for.





THE WIDER CURRICULUM

At Churchill Sixth Form, we recognise that experiences beyond the classroom are just as valuable as the academic learning within them. That's why we take pride in our extensive range of extracurricular opportunities, setting us apart from other post-16 providers.

Students will have dedicated time to expand their knowledge and skills through our **Specialist Tutor Programme**. We prepare students for life after Sixth Form, offering regular career talks and tailored support for their next steps - whether that's university, apprenticeships or employment. Whether students are budding musicians, aspiring politicians, physicists, economists or environmentalists, they will receive expert guidance and access to a variety of enriching activities to fuel their passion.

Our **Impact Groups** ensure that every student can make a positive impact within the Sixth Form, the Academy, or the local community. With time, resources and support, students will have the opportunity to lead meaningful projects of their choice. These experiences will help them to develop leadership skills as they work in teams, plan initiatives, engage with the community, and mentor younger students.

We offer a broad range of **Sports and Wellness** activities - from badminton and table tennis to competitive netball and football tournaments, as well as mindfulness and wellbeing sessions.

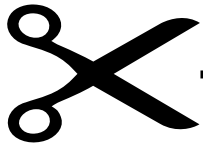
