The Academy welcomes up to 270 students into Year 7 each year, with around a third of our students joining from outside our defined catchment area. By making Churchill the first choice on your admissions selection, you give your child the best chance of securing a place.

We welcome students from a wide range of primary schools. To ensure a smooth transition, we plan to visit every child who has secured a place in Year 7 at their primary school. We work closely with their primary school to support each student as they transition to secondary school.



...to Secondary School...

In addition, all students who have secured a place will have a Transition Day at Churchill Academy & Sixth Form in Term 6. Many students will also take advantage of our Drama Day and other exciting activities to help familiarise themselves with the Academy ahead of joining us in September 2026.

We also offer a specialised transition programme for students with special educational needs, which includes additional visits to the Academy. This ensures that their individual needs are fully supported from the start.

Before we know it, students will be proudly wearing their Churchill uniform and guiding new students at next year's Open Evening!

At the Academy, we guide students through their entire secondary education, from Year 7 to Year 13. Our successful Sixth Form offers a natural progression for students, allowing them to complete their post-16 studies in a familiar and supportive environment.

Our Sixth Form isn't just a place for further study, it's a hub of leadership and inspiration. Our Sixth Form students play a crucial role in our community, mentoring younger pupils and helping to shape the Academy's culture.

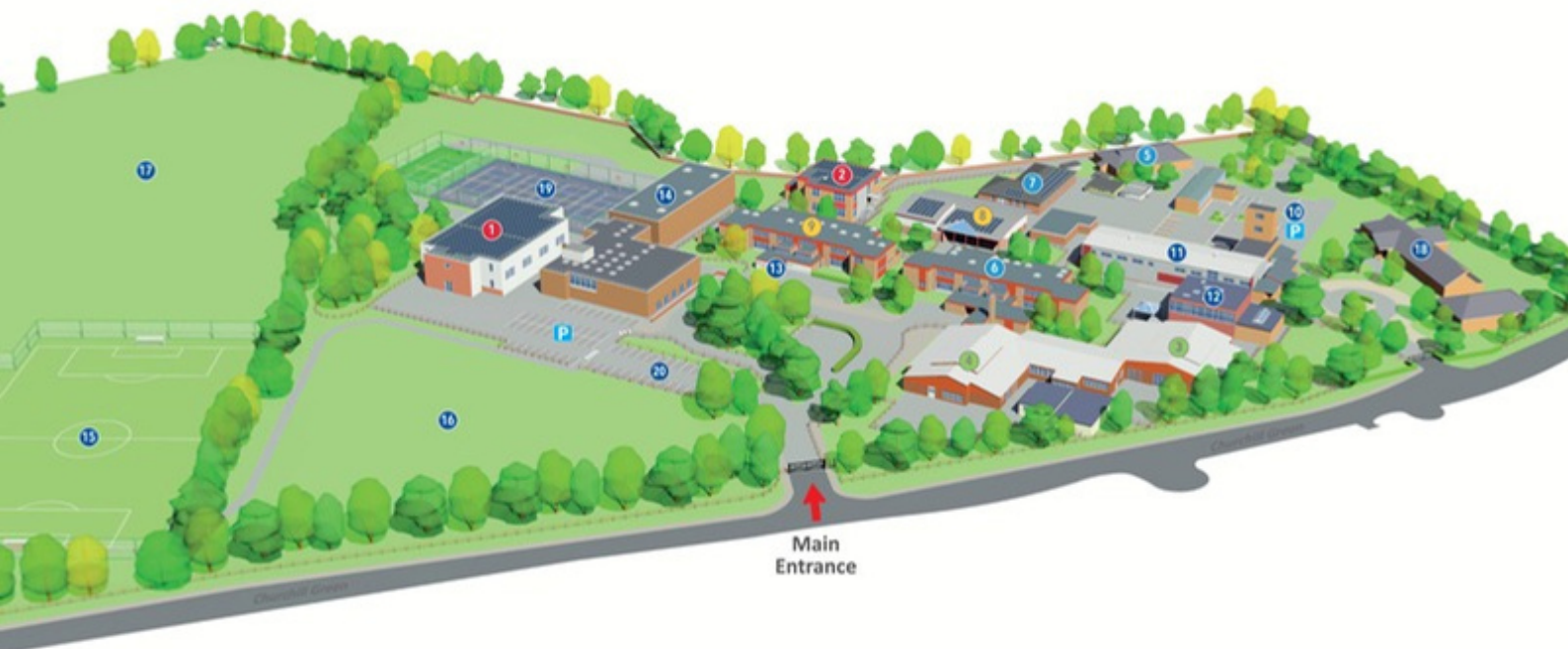

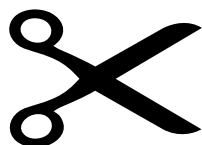
